### **Fatal Traffic Crash Information**

The Fayette County Sheriff's Office, Traffic Enforcement Section, is investigating a two vehicle traffic crash which resulted in the death of one person. The crash occurred at approximately 8:50 a.m. on Monday, October 11, 2010 on Antioch Road at its intersection with McBride Road, Fayetteville, Georgia.

Mr. Joshua Williams, 18 years old, of Fayetteville, was operating a 1995 Nissan Altima eastbound on McBride Road approaching Antioch Road. He was accompanied by Mr. James Massey, 16 years of age, of Fayetteville.

Mr. James Buck, 55 years of age, of Fayetteville, was operating a 2004 Toyota Sequoia northbound on Antioch Road. He was alone in his vehicle. As Mr. Buck entered the intersection at McBride Road, the Nissan Altima failed to stop at the stop sign and struck the Toyota Sequoia. The Toyota Sequoia left the roadway, overturned and Mr. Buck was ejected from the vehicle. The Nissan Altima came to rest on the shoulder of the roadway.

Mr. Buck was pronounced dead at the scene. Mr. Williams was injured and taken via ambulance to Southern Regional Medical Center. Mr. Massey was injured as well and transported by ambulance to Grady Memorial Hospital. Both Mr. Williams and Mr. Massey were transported by Fayette County Emergency Services ambulances. Their injuries are not thought to be life threatening.

Mr. Buck was not wearing his seatbelt at the time of the collision. Mr. Williams and Mr. Massey stated that they were wearing their seatbelts at the time of the collision.

This is the 4th fatal motor vehicle crash to have occurred in un-incorporated Fayette County in 2010.

This investigation is continuing and charges in this case are pending..
