Fayette County Sheriff's Office Makes More Mail Theft Arrests

Three individuals arrested after attempting to steal mail

FAYETTE COUNTY, GA—On October 9 at approximately 12:25 A.M., the Fayette County Sheriff's Office (FCSO) responded to a theft in progress call at the Kenwood Business Park. The FCSO Patrol Unit successfully apprehended three individuals involved in a mail theft operation at the location. Taquavion Day, Stanley Roumel Theodore Jean-Baptiste, and Latrell Mason have been arrested and are now facing multiple charges.

Units were dispatched to Kenwood Business Park following a report of a theft in progress. The complainant, who had been monitoring their security cameras, witnessed three males stealing mail. Our units arrived at the scene just as the suspects were leaving. Patrol units were able to effectively box in the vehicle, preventing the suspects from fleeing.

Subsequent investigations led to the identification and arrest of Taquavion Day, Stanley Theodore, and Latrell Mason. These individuals are currently pending numerous warrants for charges related to mail theft, VGCSA (Violation of Georgia Controlled Substances Act), and possession of tools for the commission of a crime.

During the investigation, it was determined that a total of 28 mailboxes had been unlawfully entered. The recovery of stolen mail is currently underway, and we encourage anyone with any information to make a report to the Fayette County Sheriff's Office.

We commend the quick apprehension of the suspects and extend our gratitude to the vigilant citizen who reported the crime. Their cooperation and assistance were instrumental in ensuring the successful resolution of this case. This collaborative effort between law enforcement and the community serves as a testament to the importance of active engagement in maintaining public safety.
