Fayette County Sheriff's Office Investigates Road Rage Shooting

FAYETTE COUNTY, GA – On November 4, 2024, at approximately 7:20 PM, Fayette County deputies responded to reports of a shooting that occurred near the intersection of Stanley Road and Westside Way.

Officers with the Fayetteville Police Department alerted deputies of a gunshot victim attempting to drive himself to Piedmont Fayette Hospital. The victim reported he was shot by the driver of another vehicle as he attempted to enter his neighborhood.

Fayette County Deputies responded to Stanley Road and located nine 9mm casings at the scene. The victim was transported to the hospital for treatment and was able to tell detectives he was driving home when the vehicle in front of him pulled over and the driver began shooting at him. The victim stated he did not know the shooter and this incident seemed to be the result of an irrational driver.

Later that evening, Joshua Carbin (25) of Fayetteville, turned himself in explaining he believed he shot someone that was following him. Carbin was arrested and is currently in custody at the Fayette County Jail, facing aggravated assault, aggravated battery, and possession of a firearm during the commission of a crime charges.
