Fayette County Sheriff's Office Responds to Stabbing Incident

Local man behind bars after stabbing roommates

FAYETTE COUNTY, GA- On January 30, 2024, at approximately 7:38 PM, Fayette County Deputies, Criminal Investigators, and Crime Scene Investigators responded to a call regarding a stabbing incident on Pine Knott Road in Fayetteville, Georgia.

When deputies arrived at the scene, they quickly apprehended the suspect, identified as Thomas Boykin, age 51 of Fayetteville, GA. Neighbors reported that two individuals arrived at their home asking for medical assistance. Both individuals were suffering from multiple stab wounds and were immediately transported to the closest trauma center, where they are currently in stable condition.

Thomas Boykin was charged with two counts of aggravated assault and one count of aggravated battery. This is believed to be an isolated incident and the investigation is ongoing.

The Fayette County Sheriff's Office commends the quick response of all involved parties, including the neighbors, public safety dispatchers, law enforcement officers, and emergency medical services. Their collective efforts have contributed to the successful apprehension of the suspect and the safety of our community.
