Fayette County Sheriff's Office Arrests Four Suspects in Fanny Pack Theft

Deputies locate firearm after being stolen from an UBER driver

FAYETTE COUNTY- GA, On January 5, the Fayette County Sheriff's Office responded to a report of a theft in the North Fayette County area. The incident involved the theft of a fanny pack containing a firearm and personal items from an UBER driver.

Upon receiving the dispatch from the driver, law enforcement officers were informed that the suspects had fled the scene after being confronted for taking a fanny pack from their car. Deputies were able to quickly locate the vehicle that the suspects left in.

A search of the vehicle found the firearm that the UBER driver reported to be missing from the fanny pack. Tyrek Nolley, age 25 of Atlanta, Gregory Stone, age 26 of Atlanta, Alexis Howard-Reynolds, age 24 of Stockbridge, and Zaneya Jeffries, age 25 of Atlanta were apprehended and subsequently arrested on charges of theft by taking and theft by taking (party to a crime). Additionally, Nolley had warrants out for his arrest from Atlanta Police Department and Fulton County Sheriff's Office and Stone had warrants from Forsyth Police Department, South Fulton Police Department, and Fulton County Sheriff's Office.

The stolen firearm was successfully recovered and returned to the rightful owner. Unfortunately, at this time, the fanny pack and other personal items have not been recovered. The Fayette County Sheriff's Office is actively investigating the incident and is committed to ensuring the safety of Fayette County and those who work here.
