Fayette County Sheriff's investigators are continuing to follow up on the arrest of an individual, charged with entering an auto in the Platinum Ridge subdivision early Sunday morning February 7, 2016. At 1:07am, deputies responded to an address on Platinum Ridge Point to investigate a theft of a purse from a vehicle in the victim's garage.

As a result of the investigation at the scene, and using surveillance video obtained from the subdivision, Sheriff's deputies arrested 3 hours later, 36 year old Nicholas Kyle Cooper from Peachtree City, Georgia. Warrants were issued charging Cooper with Parole Violation; Entering an Auto; Burglary; Loitering/Prowling; and Obstruction of Law Enforcement Officers.

Fayette County Sheriff's Investigators served a Search Warrant at the suspect's residence off Wynnmeade Parkway in Peachtree City and retrieved other stolen items from reported entering auto thefts in the Peachtree City area.
