Fayette County Sheriff's Office detectives have charged Andrew Edge (22) of Phoenix City, AL, Artavius Reynolds (25) of Phoenix City, AL and Xzavier Reynolds (28) of Columbus, GA in connection with two Smash and Grab style burglaries. They are currently being held in the Marion County Georgia Jail.

Charges were obtained in connection with the February 10, 2016, Smash and Grab burglaries at the Woolsey Chevron Food Mart, 1992 Highway 92 South, Fayette County and the Chevron Store at 1552 Highway 85 South, Fayette County. In both incidents, items were stolen out of the closed business after forced entry was made to the front of the stores.

Shortly after the incidents in Fayette County there were similar incidents reported in the City of Senoia and subsequent incidents on February 13, 2016 in Peachtree City, Coweta County, Spalding County and the City of Woodbury. Working on a lead developed in a Peachtree City incident, detectives from all of the agencies involved began comparing evidence and developed a vehicle and persons of interest.

Working off the information provided by detectives, deputies in Marion County, Georgia located the vehicle and three subjects shortly after similar Smash and Grab burglaries occurred in the area of Buena Vista, Georgia on February 14, 2016. The trio is currently suspected of committing burglaries in multiple jurisdictions from Georgia to Alabama.

The Fayette County Sheriff's Office would like to thank all of the agencies involved for their assistance and cooperation which made this group effort successful. These agencies include the Peachtree City Police Department, Senoia Police Department, the Coweta County Sheriff's Office, the Spalding County Sheriff's Office, Columbus Police Department and the Georgia Bureau of Investigations.
