Fayette County Sheriff's Office Assists in Apprehension of Suspect in Foot Chase

Sex Offender behind bars after multi-agency chase

FAYETTE COUNTY, GA- On November 27th, The Fayette County Sheriff's Office provided assistance in the apprehension of a suspect involved in a foot chase initiated by the Fayetteville Police Department (PD). The collaborative efforts of multiple local agencies led to the successful capture of suspect Jeremy Pullins, 37 years old, of Covington, GA.

Officers from the Fayetteville PD responded to reports of a suspicious person captured on video in the yards of residents in the Hunters Lane area. The individual matched the description of a suspect involved with recent "Peeping Tom" reports. Upon arrival, Fayetteville PD Officers made contact with a male subject who provided false identification information. When officers attempted to detain the individual, he fled on foot into the nearby woods.

The Fayette County Sheriff's Office, the Peachtree City PD and the Fayette County Marshalls Office, worked together with Fayetteville PD to locate and apprehend the suspect. The search was aided by law enforcement K-9 units, drones, and eyewitness reports from community members. Thanks to the coordinated efforts of all involved agencies the suspect was taken into custody after a two hour search.

The Fayetteville Police Department has charged Pullins with Obstruction of Law Enforcement Officers, Loitering, and Providing False Identification. Upon further investigation, Detectives with the Fayette County Sheriff's Office have charged Pullins with Failure to Register as a Sex Offender and Restricted Residence Violation.

The Fayette County Sheriff's Office commends the quick response and collaboration between all law enforcement agencies involved and their community members. The successful apprehension of the suspect highlights the dedication and teamwork within Fayette County.
