On Thursday January 29, 2015 at 11:40pm, Fayette County Sheriff's deputies were dispatched to a residence on White Tail Court off Westbridge Road in north Fayette County for a burglary attempt. The complainant told 911 someone was attempting to kick the door in at the residence. The complainant stated that three black males with dark clothing were walking away from the residence after exterior lighting came on. As deputies arrived three black males were located walking on White Tail Court. One of the suspects fled on foot towards Westbridge. The other two suspects were detained at the location. During this investigation it was determined the suspects were involved in a burglary on Wagon Wheel Circle which had occurred earlier in the day. Crime Scene Investigators were able to match a shoe print to one of the suspects from White Tail Court. As Sheriff's Investigators continued to work the incidents on White Tail Court and Wagon Wheel Circle they were able to connect yet another burglary attempt to the suspects which occurred on Thursday at 2:55pm off Covered Bridge Way. During the investigation, the suspects admitted to investigators being present at the three locations. 18 year old Jeremiah Relaford of Thornton Drive Fayetteville and 20 year old Oliver Tucker of Fairfield Circle Fayetteville were charged with two counts of burglary, and one count each of criminal attempt to commit burglary, and one count each of loitering-prowling. They are being held in the Fayette County Jail. The third suspect, 17 year old Quincy Crump of Covered Bridge Trail Fayetteville was later located after deputies executed a search warrant at his residence. He was taken into custody without incident. Crump was also charged with two counts of burglary and one count of criminal attempt to commit burglary. All the stolen items consisting of firearms and a laptop computer were recovered.
