On December 19, 2012, the Fayette County Tactical Narcotics Team (TNT) arrested 17 year old Patrick Wilson of Riverdale, Georgia and 52 year old Jeffrey Smith of Jonesboro, Georgia. Wilson and Smith traveled to Fayette County to sell marijuana to undercover agents and were subsequently arrested on the border of Clayton and Fayette County. Both individuals were charged with the sale of marijuana, possession of marijuana with the intent to distribute, possession of a controlled substance (Vicodin), possession of a firearm during the commission of a crime, obstruction of a law enforcement officer, and possession of a pirated DVD.

On December 31, 2012, 45 year old Harold Evans of Douglasville, Georgia was arrested by the Fayette County Sheriff's Office. He was charged with one felony count of identity fraud. The case originated when Mr. Evans used the identifying information of a Fayette County resident to pay his own utility bill.

On January 3, 2013, Fayette County Tactical Narcotics Team (TNT) investigators conducted an operation at the Fayette Pavilion and arrested 23 year old Omar Simpkins of Smyrna, Georgia. Simpkins sold a quantity of marijuana to an undercover officer, was arrested and booked into the Fayette County Jail. He was charged with the sale of marijuana and for being in possession of cocaine with the intent to distribute.

On January 3, 2013, Clifford Oliver Gill of LaGrange, Georgia was arrested by the Fayette County Sheriff's Office and charged with one felony count of theft by receiving, and one misdemeanor count of theft by receiving. Gill is accused of taking items from a home he was living at in 2012. The homeowners filed a theft report with the Sheriff's Office after discovering the items missing. Sheriff's investigators were able to track down the stolen items and arrest Clifford Gill.
