ATTEMPT TO IDENTIFY THEFT SUSPECTS

On July 26, 2012 at 12:48PM the Fayette County Sheriff's Office responded to Kauffman Tire, 240 Peachtree East Shopping Center, Fayette County, Georgia in reference to a distraction theft.

Two white males entered Kauffman Tire and engaged an employee in a discussion about vehicle service. One of the white males lured the employee away from the cash register. The second white male, wearing a pink shirt, forced open the cash register and removed an undisclosed amount of money.

A second employee quickly discovered the theft after observing the male wearing the pink shirt walking away from the area of the cash register. The employee observed the male entering a Publix Supermarket nearby and confronted him. The employee was able to retrieve an amount of money before the male fled in a vehicle with the other male subject.

The vehicle is described as a light bronze or tan 1990 to 1993 Honda Accord with a bungee cord or strap holding on a portion of the front bumper and a spare tire on the right rear.

The driver of the vehicle is described as a white male with a medium to heavy build in his mid to late 40's with salt and pepper hair.

The second male is described as a white male with a slender build with salt and pepper hair in his mid to late 40's wearing a pink polo style shirt and light colored pants.

The Sheriff's Office is attempted to identify these men and the vehicle. A photo obtained from video footage taken at Publix has been included with this release showing the male with the pink shirt.
