VEHICLE BREAK-IN UPDATE

On Sunday, July 20, 2014 approximately 22 vehicles were entered while parked at residences in the Shenandoah Estates subdivision off Old Highway 138 in Fayette County. While responding to the area sheriff's deputies located a suspicious male carrying several items. The male fled from deputies on a bicycle.

The majority of the vehicles appear to have been unlocked and small items of value were removed. The items included loose change, shoes, ammunition and electronics. Sheriff Babb would like to remind everyone to lock their vehicle doors and keep valuables out of sight to deter crimes of this type.

****UPDATE****

On Wednesday, July 23, 2014 several vehicles were entered while parked at residences in the Newton Plantation Subdivision and the Legacy Hills Subdivision. These incidents were similar in nature to the incidents on July 20, 2014.

****ARREST UPDATE****

On July 31, 2014 Fayette County Sheriff's Office arrested 22 year old Randen Morris of Atlanta, Georgia. Morris is charged with 31 felony counts of entering auto. Fayette County Investigators used surveillance footage and other evidence collected to identify Morris and connect these incidents.

Members of the U.S. Marshals South Eastern Regional Fugitive Task Force located Morris in the Bankhead neighborhood of Atlanta and took him into custody. Sheriff Barry H. Babb stated, "This quick arrest would have not occurred without our partnership with the U.S. Marshals Office and their continued hard work for us all in the metro area."
