Fatal Traffic Crash Information

The Fayette County Sheriff's Office, Traffic Enforcement Section, is investigating a single vehicle traffic crash which resulted in the death of one person. The crash occurred at approximately 1:04 p.m. on Tuesday, June 12, 2012 on Georgia Highway 92 South, near Old Farm Road, Woolsey, Georgia.

Mr. John M. Fulop, 63 years of age, of Griffin, was operating his 1994 BMW 325i southbound on Georgia Highway 92 South. He was alone in the vehicle.

As Mr. Fulop's vehicle entered a curve on Georgia Highway 92 South, it continued straight and left the roadway for reasons as yet not known. After leaving the roadway, the BMW struck a telephone pole and tree before coming to rest. Mr. Fulop was wearing his seatbelt.

Mr. Fulop sustained serious injuries and was transported by the Fayette County Fire Department to Atlanta Medical Center where he later died.

This collision remains under investigation by the Traffic Enforcement Section in order to determine fully the cause of this crash and Mr. Fulop's death.

This is the 2nd fatal motor vehicle collision to have occurred in un-incorporated Fayette County in 2012.
