On June 21, 2013, the Fayette County Sheriff's Office responded to a burglary in progress on Tyrone Road. The victim of the burglary called 911 after a white male kicked his door in. When the perpetrator, later identified as Darrell Shaun Taylor, encountered the homeowner he said "oops, wrong house" and fled the scene. As he was leaving, the victim gave a detailed description of Taylor's car. Tyrone Police spotted the car and Taylor was taken into custody by the Tyrone Police Department. As Taylor was being transported to the jail, he kicked out the rear window of the Fayette County patrol car. As the deputy stopped the car, Taylor jumped out of the window and began to run down the street while handcuffed. He was taken into custody after a short chase and booked into the Fayette County Jail. Taylor is charged with burglary (felony), obstruction of a law enforcement officer (misdemeanor), interference with government property (felony), and escape (felony). Taylor is considered a suspect in other similar crimes and the Fayette County Sheriff's Office is working closely with the Coweta County Sheriff's Office as Taylor is suspected in crimes there as well.
