Burglary Suspect in Custody

On Wednesday March 11, 2015 at 1:14am, Fayette County Sheriff's Deputies responded to the 300 block of Rocky Fork Blvd on an alarm call. Several homes are under construction on this street and deputies arrived to find copper wire and pipe cut from the exterior and interior of the homes. Deputies located a large pile of copper wire and pipe rolled up laying on the ground behind two homes in the development. In the cul-de-sac of Rocky Fork Blvd deputies located a 2015 UHAUL van unlocked. Deputies discovered evidence inside the rented UHAUL which Sheriff's Detectives were able to use to locate a suspect in Jonesboro for questioning. At approximately 8:30am on Wednesday, Sheriff's Detectives after interviewing the suspect and finding physical evidence at the suspect's residence took into custody 30 year old Theodore Carter from Jonesboro, Georgia. Carter is charged with two counts of Burglary and is being held in the Fayette County Jail. Carter also had warrants for his arrest out of Spaulding County for a drug charge.
