On March 20, 2014 Fayette County Sheriff's Deputies took a report in reference to a public indecency incident at the Fayette County Library in Fayetteville, Georgia. A group of teenage females witnessed a black male exposing himself to the group while the girls were studying. Staff confronted the black male inside the library after the girls reported the man was "doing something he shouldn't be." The male told staff his name was Cecil Smith as he was walking out of the library. He was last seen in the parking lot, driving away in a dark colored 4-door sedan with dark tinted windows. He was wearing a black baseball cap, dark polo shirt, and dark pants with a lanyard hanging out of the right pocket. Fayette County Sheriff's Detectives are seeking assistance in this case. Anyone with information on the male in the video is asked to call Det. Parker at 770-716-4752.
