In the early morning hours of March 23, 2014, Fayette County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a robbery call on Camelot Drive in Fayette County. Upon arrival, deputies found that there were multiple victims who told officers that they had been robbed of cash, cell phones, and other personal belongings. The victims were attendees at an after prom party being held on Camelot Drive. They were standing on the street when they were approached by eight to nine black males brandishing pistols. After the items were taken from the victims, the several of the perpetrators discharged their weapons as they fled on foot. None of the victims were struck or injured. The initial complainant deputies met with on scene is a Sandy Creek High School Assistant Principal. The incident took place in the street near her residence and she was cooperative with detectives during their investigation, which is still continuing.

The perpetrators are described as eight to nine young black males wearing dark clothing. Several of the males are described as having dreadlocks.
