On March 21, 2013, The Fayette County Sheriff's Office Tactical Narcotics Team conducted a drug investigation at 2664 S Hwy 92 (Sunoco Station) Fayetteville, Georgia which resulted in the arrest of two subjects. The first subject, 23 year old Adam Womack of Griffin, Georgia was charged with four counts of sale of meth, possession of meth with the intent to distribute, and tampering with evidence. The second subject, 50 year old Ronnie Moore of McDonough, Georgia was charged with possession of methamphetamine with the intent to distribute, possession of marijuana less than one ounce, and two counts of tampering with evidence.

On March 21, 2013 Fayette County Sheriff's Deputies were conducting a road safety check at New Hope Road and Whitney Way. A 2008 Nissan Titan approached the checkpoint and deputies noticed the driver was spraying air freshener before rolling down his windows to speak to them. Deputies identified the driver as 28 year old Anthony Parker of Fairburn, Georgia. The presence of smoke and the strong odor of burning marijuana led deputies to investigate further. Upon searching the vehicle, officers located several large bags containing approximately three pounds of suspected marijuana. Parker was arrested and charged with possession of marijuana with intent to distribute.

On March 25, 2013, at 0803 hours, the Fayette County Sheriff's Office responded to 146 Vaughn Drive Fayetteville, Georgia in reference to an aggravated assault. The investigation revealed that two care takers were working in the residence for a business, Shirley Home Away From Home, caring for three adult handicapped patients. Two care takers got into an altercation and one of the care takers discharged two rounds from a handgun at the other care taker. The victim was struck in the leg. The injury was superficial and the victim did not want to be transported to the hospital. Twenty seven year old Ashley Jaunese Mason of Atlanta, Georgia was arrested on scene charged with aggravated assault.
