Fayette County Sheriff's Office investigators made an arrest on May 22 in connection with a forgery case which occurred on April 3, 2012. Investigators have arrested Teneisha Morrison, 28, of Stone Mountain charging her with Forgery in the 1st Degree.

This case involves Morrison depositing a forged check in the amount of \$2,100.00 into a Suntrust account where she later withdrew the money. The forged check belonged to a Fayette County victim.

Fayette County Sheriff's Office investigators made an arrest on May 21 in connection with a title fraud case which occurred on March 22, 2012. Investigators have arrested Kelvin Williams, 54, of Fayetteville charging him with two (2) counts of Theft by Deception, two (2) counts of Endangering the Security Interest of a Lien Holder, and two (2) counts of Failure to Convey Title.

This case involves Williams selling a 2001 Jeep Cherokee and a 2005 Nissan Maxima which both had title liens on them. Williams was unable to surrender the titles to the two (2) victims due to the title liens.

Fayette County Sheriff's Office investigators made an arrest on May 24 in connection with an armed robbery on Carnegie Place in north Fayette County which occurred on May 19, 2012. Investigators have arrested a Fayette County Juvenile in connection with this case and charged him with Aggravated Assault and Criminal Attempt to Commit Armed Robbery. Additional charges in this case are being considered.

This case occurred when the victim was checking the mail at the Carnegie business complex. The victim told the reporting deputy that the suspect approached the rear of her car while she was sitting in the driver's seat in front of the mailboxes on Carnegie Place. The victim said the suspect pointed a handgun at her and demanded for her to surrender her purse. The victim refused to surrender her purse and accelerated away from the suspect in her car at a high rate of speed. As the victim was driving away the juvenile discharged the handgun towards the victim where no one was hurt in this incident. Statements given to Fayette investigators by the victim and other witnesses allowed for investigators to positively identify the suspect.
