On May 24, 2013, Fayette County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a disturbance call at 325 Elderberry Trace Fayetteville, Georgia. Upon arrival, deputies learned that 29 year old Jessica Tolbert had been stabbed multiple times. Fayette County Fire and Emergency Services rushed Tolbert to Fayette Piedmont Hospital where she succumbed to her wounds. Sheriff's Detectives and Crime Scene Investigators at the incident location were able to determine that Tolbert's ex-boyfriend had left the scene just before deputies arrived. Tolbert had been in a relationship with 45 year old Terry Bernard Davis of Oxford, Georgia but recently separated from him. After collecting evidence at the scene and speaking to witnesses, detectives sought arrest warrants for Davis. After the arrest warrant was issued, Davis was arrested in Atlanta at 3:45 am. The Fayette County Sheriff's Office was assisted by the U.S. Marshall's Southeastern Regional Fugitive Taskforce and the Atlanta Police Department. Terry Davis is currently being housed at the Fayette County Jail and charged with murder.
