On May 2, 2015 at 4:26 am, Fayette County Sheriff's deputies were given a look-out for a white Ford work truck in the area of Highway 92 North at Newton Road. The truck was being followed by a citizen who witnessed the theft of Comcast Communications amplifiers. The citizen was able to relay information to 911 on the direction of travel as the truck went into Fulton County and then came back inside Fayette County on Highway 279 where deputies located the truck and performed a traffic stop at 794 Highway 279. During the investigation, cable amplifiers and batteries belonging to Comcast Communications were located in plain view. The driver, 51 year old Bruce Edward Jarrard of Jonesboro and passenger, 51 year old Charles Randall Nunn of College Park were arrested and charged with one count each of Theft by Receiving Stolen Property. This case is still under investigation and more charges are expected in Fulton and Clayton County.
