On November 14, 2014 at approximately 12:38am Fayette County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a residence located at 1746 Highway 54 West in reference to a domestic call. Deputies arrived at the location and discovered a male victim upstairs in bed with severe injuries to his head caused by a baseball bat. Witness at the residence told deputies the dispute started when the victim was heard arguing with his girlfriend upstairs making derogatory statements about the perpetrator's girlfriend who was downstairs. 23 year old Emmanuel Landeros-Lopez of Fayetteville went upstairs with a baseball bat and struck the victim multiple times in the head. According to Fayette County EMS personnel at the scene, the victim sustained a depressed skull fracture and was transported to Atlanta Medical Center in critical condition. Landeros was taken into custody at the scene and charged with aggravated battery. He is currently in the Fayette County Jail being held without bond.
