On November 13, 2014 at about 2:10pm a Sheriff's Deputy initiated a traffic stop for no tag displayed in the area of Highland Drive near Old Hwy. 138 in North Fayette County. The driver continued leaving Fayette County and entered Clayton County on Creekside Drive. Choosing not to comply, the driver, 18 year old Rosie Nelson and passenger, 18 year old Princess Holmes, both Stockbridge residents, fled from the vehicle while it was still in motion. The Sheriff's Deputy was able to apprehend both after a short foot chase. However, the vehicle continued moving and crashed into a home on Creekside Drive.

Nelson was arrested and charged on three Uniform Traffic Citations with No License Plate on Vehicle, Fleeing or Attempting to Elude, and Failure to Have License on Person. Holmes returned as a wanted person for misdemeanor Failure to Appear in Henry County and was arrested on that outstanding warrant. Clayton County Police Department responded reference the vehicle collision into the home. There were no injuries.
