Fayette County Sheriff's Investigators made an arrest on October 31 in connection with an identity theft case which occurred on January 28, 2011. Investigators have arrested Tiffany Robinson, 29, of Americus and charged her with one (1) count of Identity Fraud.

This case involved Robinson fraudulently depositing a stolen check belonging to a Fayette County citizen into her JP Morgan checking account.

Fayette County Sheriff's Investigators made an arrest on October 27 in connection with a child molestation case which occurred between January and August 2011. Investigators have arrested Nathan Donald Moore, 24, of Fayetteville and charged him with six (6) counts of Aggravated Child Molestation, six (6) counts of Child Molestation and one (1) count of Enticing a Child for Indecent Purposes.

This case involved Moore having sexual contact with a juvenile victim at a residence in south Fayette County on at least six different occasions.

Fayette County Sheriff's Investigators made an arrest on November 2 in connection with at least twenty six (26) stolen cars that were recovered between May and November 2011 at Quality Used Auto Parts and M&S Auto Parts located on Roberts Road in north Fayette County. Investigators have arrested Christopher Davis, 53, of Atlanta and charged him with twenty six (26) felony counts of Theft by Receiving Stolen Vehicles.

This case involved Davis selling at least twenty six (26) stolen vehicles to both Quality Used Auto Parts and M&S Auto parts. The stolen cars were then crushed for their recyclable metals. Representatives from both Quality Used Auto Parts and M&S Auto Parts provided information to Fayette Investigators which led to Davis's arrest.
