Case #S1436686 Robbery

On Saturday, September 13, 2014 at approximately 8:30am a 70 year old Fayette County resident on Dix-Lee-On Drive was approached outside of his vehicle after an early morning shopping trip by a male brandishing a handgun. The male pointed the handgun at the victim demanding the victim give him everything. The male fled the scene in the victim's dark blue 2005 Cadillac CTS (Georgia tag: BJJF 6453).

The suspect male is described as a light skinned black male in his early twenties approximately 5 ft. 8 in. tall and weighing 150 lbs. to 170 lbs. The male may have been the passenger in a tan or brown in color small Dodge truck believed to be a Dakota.

The resident was returning home from work after shopping on Old National Highway and investigators are not ruling out that he may have been followed to his home.

Sheriff's investigators are currently working leads in the investigation and are asking anyone with information to call the Criminal Investigations Division at 770-716-4750, Sgt. B. Lee at 770-716-4888 or Lt. E. Harper at 770-716-4763.

On Friday, September 12, 2014 at approximately 2:00pm a resident of the NorthRidge Subdivision off Highway 279, Fayette County, reported observing a male subject looking through a neighbors mail.

Responding deputies were able to locate Henry Mitchell (57 yoa), of College Park, who was in possession of items stolen from at least one mailbox in the subdivision. Mitchell was placed under arrest.

The theft of items from commercial and residential mailboxes continues to be a key starting point for crimes such as Forgery and Identity Fraud. Residents and business owners are asked to report suspicious activity immediately by calling 911.

On Saturday, September 6, 2014 at approximately 7:30am a Sheriff's deputy located two suspicious persons occupying a vehicle at an address near the intersection of Westbridge Road and Old Ford Road.

Further investigation by deputies led to the arrest of Derrick Carr (30 yoa) of Riverdale, Georgia and Clifton Paige (28 yoa) of Atlanta, Georgia. Both subjects were charged with Burglary, Theft by Receiving Stolen Property and Possession of Tools for the Commission of a Crime.

Seven reported stolen HVAC units were recovered along with additional HVAC units and lawn equipment.
