Two Women Arrested Following Undercover Operation at Fayette County Massage Parlor

Local Spa Closed After Undercover Investigation Reveals Illegal Activity

FAYETTE COUNTY, GA – Two women have been arrested following an undercover investigation into alleged illegal activity at a massage parlor in Fayette County.

The investigation began after the Fayette County Sheriff's Office received multiple complaints regarding suspected prostitution-related activity at the business. The Fayette County Special Operations Division conducted an undercover investigation to evaluate the complaints and determine whether illegal activity was occurring. During the investigation, authorities determined that sexual acts were being performed on customers in exchange for money.

Yufang Zhou and Melaing Wang were taken into custody and charged with masturbation for hire. Both individuals were transported to the Fayette County Jail without incident. The business, The Day Spa, located at 1408 West Highway 54 in Fayetteville, has since been closed by Fayette County officials.

The Fayette County Sheriff's Office commends its staff for their dedication and hard work during this investigation and appreciates the assistance of surrounding agencies.
